### Soup Kitchen Success!

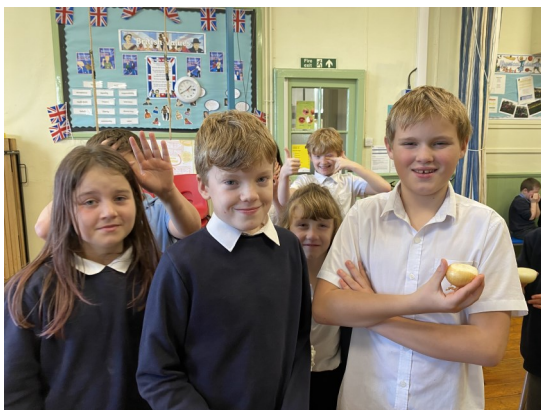
This week in school we celebrated Harvest, but this year we put a spin on it!

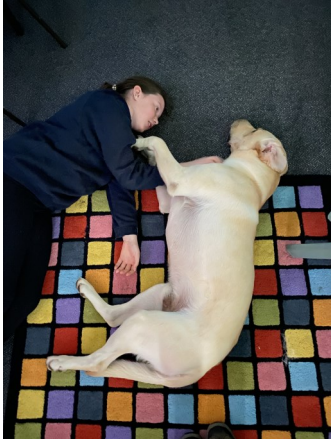
