Improvements

More guidance with reading materials at the beginning – Mrs Speare and I will ensure that new parents are fully informed about how they can support their child in reading when they start school.

Music lessons – I have arranged a delivery of different musical instruments throughout the year so that children can learn a range of instruments. Previously, the PTFA have agreed to pay for music lessons in school but when I asked for music teachers to come to school no body came forward. I will continue to look into this.

Swimming lessons for all – Due to covid, swimming lessons have not taken place for the whole school but it is booked for the next academic year!

Pushing the more able children – I have spoken to Tavistock college about ways in which we can support more able children in a range of subjects.
