Overall conclusions:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All parents are satisfied with the school. All parents agree that their child enjoys attending this school and is making good progress due to the teaching being good and high expectations. All parents agree that the school is well led and managed. All parents agree that the behaviour in the school is good and is helping their child to become mature and responsible. This demonstrates a positive impact on the newly implemented behaviour policy. All parents agree that their child is safe in school. This demonstrates that the school has strong safeguarding procedures and pastoral care. The vast majority agree that the school is providing a wide range of curriculum enrichments and extra-curricular opportunities. All parents agree that they are kept well informed about how their child is getting on through reports, parent consultations, Class Dojo, weekly newsletter and the Facebook page. This demonstrates that parental engagement has really improved. All parents are now signed up to ClassDojo.
Next steps:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Homework: We have ensured that all pupils are receiving homework this year. All pupils are encouraged to read daily, practise their spellings/phonics and times tables (in Years 2 – 6). Buzzards’ Class also receive a half-termly homework menu where they can choose activities as many activities as they would like related to their current topic to complete. Don’t forget that the

children can also post photos and videos on ClassDojo related to their home learning. We are also going to start posting ClassDojo home learning challenges.

- Website: The website has been really updated this year and now includes updated class pages, staff lists and contacts, newsletters, KS2 results, history of the school, relevant policies, curriculum overviews, Special Educational Needs information, Visible Learning and Safeguarding.
