

The questions asked were to ascertain the SEND children's views of Princetown School. Eight questionnaires were completed by pupils at SEN Support / EHCP. An additional questionnaire was completed by an EYFS pupil, but only questions 1, 3, 14 (due to their level of understanding) and indicating which 'face' for the classroom / playtime views. The SENDCo read the questions and asked the children to rate each question. Where children struggled to understand the question, it was rephrased to aid understanding.
