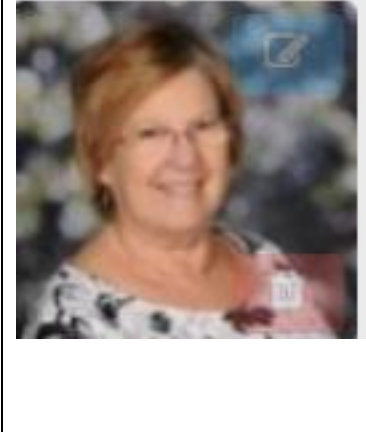


Princetown- Meet the Governors
